Background

- Since 2005 (FY 2006), COG/TPB staff has maintained a consultant-assisted project to provide assistance with the application and development of the COG/TPB travel demand model.
- Project has been conducted using a series of one-year contracts, each of which can be extended for up to two additional years.
- Thus, re-biding usually occurs every three years:
 FY 2009, 2012, 2015
- As announced last meeting: FY 15 consultant is Cambridge Systematics, Inc. (CS)
- We again thank AECOM for their assistance over last three years!



Major deliverables for this project

- End-of-fiscal-year report summarizing work conducted
 - Every year
- Modeling files
 - Some years, depending on task orders





AECOM's FY 14 end-of-year report

- Report dated 6/30/14 was distributed to TFS at its July 18 meeting
- TFS was provided a 30-day review and comment
- No comments were received from TFS or external staff
- COG staff had some comments
 - Minor edits, e.g. typos
 - Follow-up questions on technical details
- Minor edits: Incorporated into report dated 8/18/14 (available on TFS website)
- □ Staff will follow up with AECOM in Sept.



Work in FY 2015: Testing AECOM files

- Model enhancements proposed by AECOM that COG/TPB staff will test out and consider for inclusion in future model releases:
 - Automated procedure for calculating the percent of each zone within walking distance to transit
 - Enhancements to HOV-lane and HOT-lane modeling, including new routine for toll setting on HOT lanes
 - Conversion of transit path-building software:
 - From TRNBUILD to PT
 - Conversion of the mode choice application program:
 - From AEMS (Fortran) to ModeChoice (C++/TRANSIMS)



FY 15 work with CS

- A kickoff meeting was held between CS and COG/TPB staff on Aug. 1.
- Topics
 - Assistance implementing considered enhancements
 - Discussed possible task orders for FY 15
 - Assistance developing a new strategic plan for models development
 - Review of transit modeling with respect to FTA guidance
 - Version control software and bug/issue tracking software



FY 15 work with CS

- Sept. 17: CS has sent proposals for task orders 15.2 and 15.3:
 - 15.2 Technical assistance in developing a new strategic plan for models development
 - 15.3 Review of transit modeling with respect to FTA guidance
- COG/TPB staff will review proposals and respond to CS
