TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights October 3, 2003

The Technical Committee met on Friday, October 3 at COG. Four items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on October 15.

TPB agenda Item 9

Staff briefed the Committee on the draft results of the air quality conformity analysis of the 2003 Constrained Long Range Plan (CLRP) and FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Committee recommended that the draft conformity analysis be released for public comment on October 15.

TPB agenda Item 10

The Committee reviewed draft maps and lists of projects in the 2003 CLRP and the draft FY 2004-2009 TIP document. The Committee recommended that the CLRP and TIP documents be released for public comment on October 15.

TPB agenda Item 11

The Committee was briefed on draft lists of projects to be removed or modified in the draft 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP in order to create interim CLRP and TIP documents. The Committee recommended that the project information to develop interim CLRP and TIP documents be released for public comment on October 15.

• TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was briefed on the activities for the revised State Implementation Plan (SIP) to be submitted in early 2004 and on the schedule and activities of the Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) SIP Management Task Force.

Four items were presented for information and discussion:

- Staff briefed the Committee on the new study to quantify the region's near-tern transit and highway funding needs and priorities and to identify specific sources of revenues over the six-year period 2004 to 2009. The study is scheduled to be completed in draft for presentation to the TPB at its December 17 meeting.
- Staff briefed the Committee on the Travel Forecasting Subcommittee meeting on September 26 that reviewed the Transportation Research Board's (TRB) first letter report on "A Review of Travel Demand Modeling by the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board" and initial TPB staff comments on the report.
- The Committee was briefed on the status of the analysis of the recently released 2000 Census Journey to Work data on place of residence and workplace at the transportation analysis zone level.
- Staff reviewed the status of the alternative land use scenarios for the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study. The transportation subgroup will meet to identify transportation scenarios on October 20. The next meeting of the Joint Technical

Working Group (JTWG) for this study is scheduled for October 10.
