At its meeting of December 3, 2004, the TPB Steering Committee approved the following resolutions:

- ❖ TPB SR7-2005: Resolution on an amendment to the FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) that is exempt from the air quality conformity requirement to modify the funding and phasing for two projects in Fairfax and Prince William Counties, two park and ride lots in Loudoun County, and five traffic signal projects in Arlington County, the City of Alexandria, City of Manassas, and the Towns of Herndon and Vienna; and to add two road projects in Loudoun County as requested by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2003 the TPB adopted the 2003 Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan (CLRP) and the FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, in the attached letter of November 23, 2004, VDOT on behalf of the Town of Vienna and itself have requested an amendment to the FY 2004-2009 TIP to modify the funding and phasing for a US 29 project in Fairfax County, for the VA 28 Broad Run Bridge project in Prince William County, for five traffic signal projects in Arlington County, the City of Alexandria, the City of Manassas, and the Towns of Herndon and Vienna, and for two park-and ride lots in Loudoun County; and to add two projects to pave gravel segments of VA 643 in Loudoun County, as described in the attached materials; and

WHEREAS, these projects are included in the current conformity analysis or are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement, as defined in Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations "40 CFR Parts 51 and 93 Transportation Conformity Rule Amendments: Flexibility and Streamlining; Final Rule," issued in the August 15, 1997 Federal Register,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Steering Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board amends the FY 2004-2009 TIP to modify the funding and phasing for a US 29 project in Fairfax County, for the VA 28 Broad Run Bridge project in Prince William County, for five traffic signal projects in Arlington County, the City of Alexandria, the City of Manassas, and the Towns of Herndon and Vienna, and for two

park-and ride lots in Loudoun County; and to add two projects to pave gravel segments of VA 643 in Loudoun County, as described in the attached materials.

On behalf of the Town of Vienna (request attached) and itself, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests an amendment (also attached) to the FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Table 1 describes the individual projects included in the TIP amendment, including the reason(s) each project is included in this request, conformity status, and funding implications.

In summary, this amendment will move project phases into FY 2005 and modify funding amounts (as necessary) for a US 29 project in Fairfax County, for the VA 28 Broad Run Bridge project in Prince William County, for five ITS-related traffic signal projects in various NoVA jurisdictions, and for two park-and-ride lots in Loudoun County. Additionally, two projects to pave gravel segments of VA 643 in Loudoun County will be added to the FY 2004-2009 TIP.
