


Transit Screens communicate aggregated, real-time transit feeds at any location with a single, cloud-based display. Transit Screens include all major transit agencies in the greater Washington, DC area, (ie. Metro, Metrobus, Capital Bikeshare, Circulator, ART, and PG The Bus.) Coverage includes SF Bay Area and can easily extend to other regions and agencies.

- Make it easier for customers to use public transit, reducing parking demand
- · Keep customers comfortably inside your store instead of outside waiting for transit
- Provide a useful timesaving amenity to help customers and employees travel safely

**For commercial property management, residential apartment buildings, and retail:** Use a Transit Screen in your lobby to:

- Instantly demonstrate all transportation choices to prospective or current tenants
- Add interest to a lobby, demonstrate technology savvy
- Increase resident and visitor comfort and save time
- · Improve quality of front desk services at low cost

**Requirements:** Internet (wired or Wi-Fi); power connection; display screen (7" to HDTV). Screens have performed successfully at beta test sites in public retail locations. Transit Screens also work on desktop computers and mobile devices.
