Key Schedule & Budget - Updates

- **Bay TMDL Implementation Schedule**
(see *CBP General Updates* document for details)
 - Final Phase III WIP Planning Targets – mid-July 2018
 - Draft Phase III WIPs (w/ climate - narrative & # option) – March 2019
 - Final Draft Conowingo WIP– March 2019
 - Final Phase III WIPs – late June (July?) 2019
 - Climate Change Loads/Phase III WIP Addendum (beyond narrative)– September 2021
- **Meeting TMDL Goals**
 - 2017 60% Goal – TN (no), TP/TSS (yes)
 - 2025 100% Goal – TN (gap), TP/TSS (close)
- **CBP Funding**
 - FY 2018 federal omnibus bill (3/27/18)
 - **Full funding** (\$73 million) for CBP
 - Funding for *Bay Journal*
 - New – Potential to move CBP offices; resistance



Bay TMDL Implementation – Recap

- Continued need to monitor/provide input/protect COG members' interests
- Conowingo Dam/Susquehanna WIP (e.g., ~6 M lb. TN)
 - Separate WIP process; & MDE defined Exelon responsibility (~100% ?)
 - Questions – Where will actual load reductions come from? What are potential opportunities/conflicts? How/will this affect COG's members?
 - Recommendation to CBPC – letter to PSC
- Climate Change Impacts (e.g., ~9 M lb. TN)
 - Science to better model/quantify impacts & BMP impacts
 - New interim deadlines & planned Phase III WIP Addendum
 - Narrative with # option – but there will be #'s by 2021/2022
- Development of the Phase 3 WIPs
 - Some adjustments likely, schedule delays, special cases
 - How will TN gaps be addressed/implications?
 - Integration with Conowingo WIP?
