



Recent Events


- Sept. 2: President Obama announces decision not to revise 2008 ozone standard
- Sept. 20: EPA proposes Washington DC-MD-VA region has Clean Data for 1997 ozone standard
- Sept. 22: EPA announces it will enforce the 2008 ozone standard, issue implementation guidance


1997 Ozone Standard: 85 ppb





2008 Ozone Standard: 75 ppb





EPA to enforce 2008 Standard

- EPA announced that it will enforce the 2008 ozone standard (9/22/11)
- 10/28/11: States submit revised recommendations for nonattainment areas
- 12/15/11 EPA will send proposed designation letters to states (120 days)
- 4/30/12: EPA will finalize designations (FR notice)
- Ozone Implementation Guidance in fall 2011
- Ozone Monitoring Rule in fall 2011

Classification Standards

- Marginal 0.076 0.086 ppm
- Moderate 0.086 0.100 ppm
- Serious 0.100 0.113
- Severe 0.113 0.175
- Extreme 0.175 and up

Washington, DC-MD-VA: MARGINAL (potentially)

- EPA expects attainment by 2015 due to
 - Cross-State Air Pollution Rule
 - Light & Heavy Duty Vehicle Standards
 - Rules under development (Ex: Tier 3 vehicle and fuel standards)
- SIP requirements:
 - Mobile budgets
 - Attainment demonstration
