# Title VI and Environmental Justice

## Title VI: Civil Rights Act of 1964

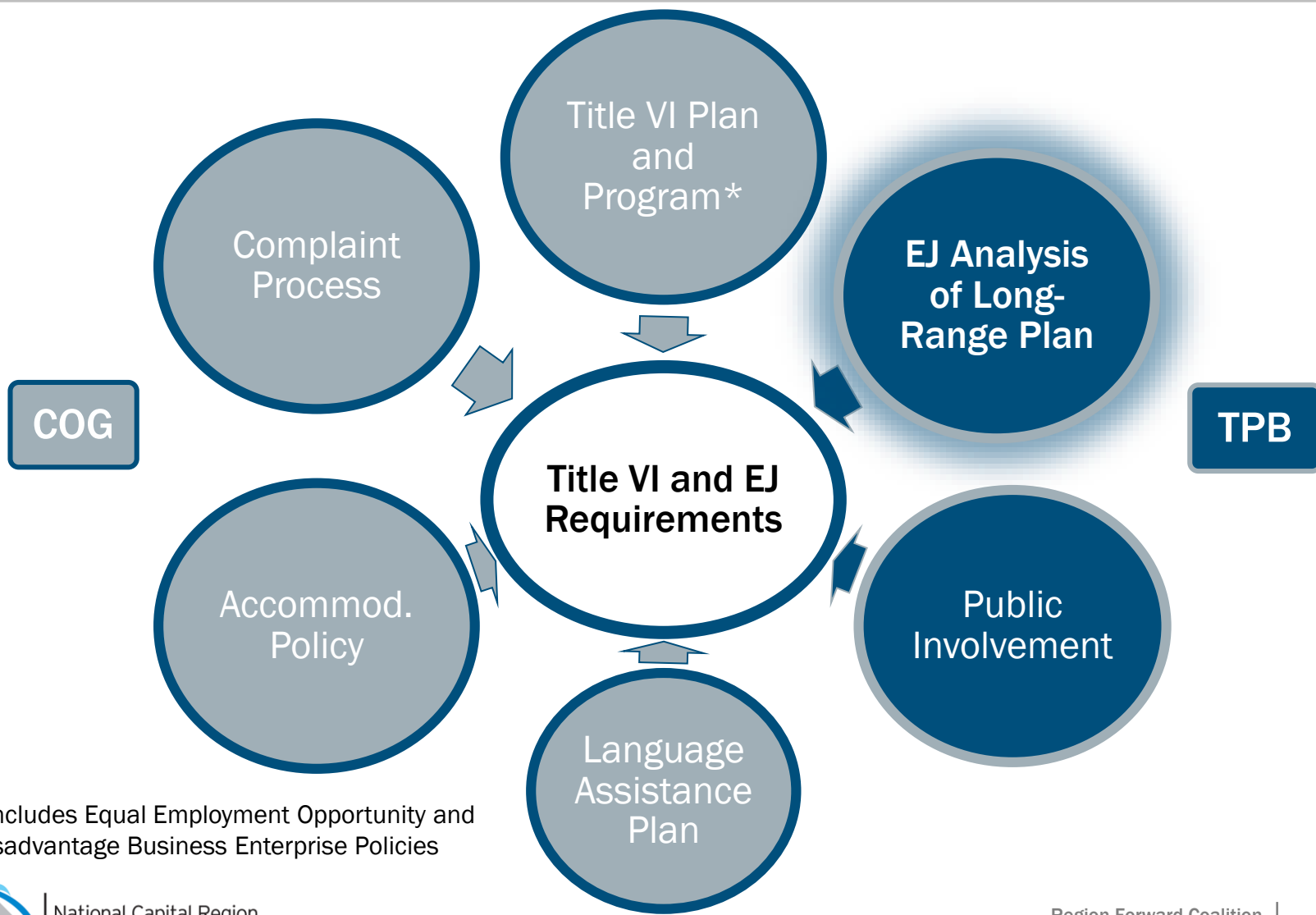
Prohibit discrimination based on **race, color, or national origin** under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance

## Environmental Justice (EO 12898)

Recipients of Federal funds must identify and avoid disproportionately high and adverse effects on **minority and low-income populations**



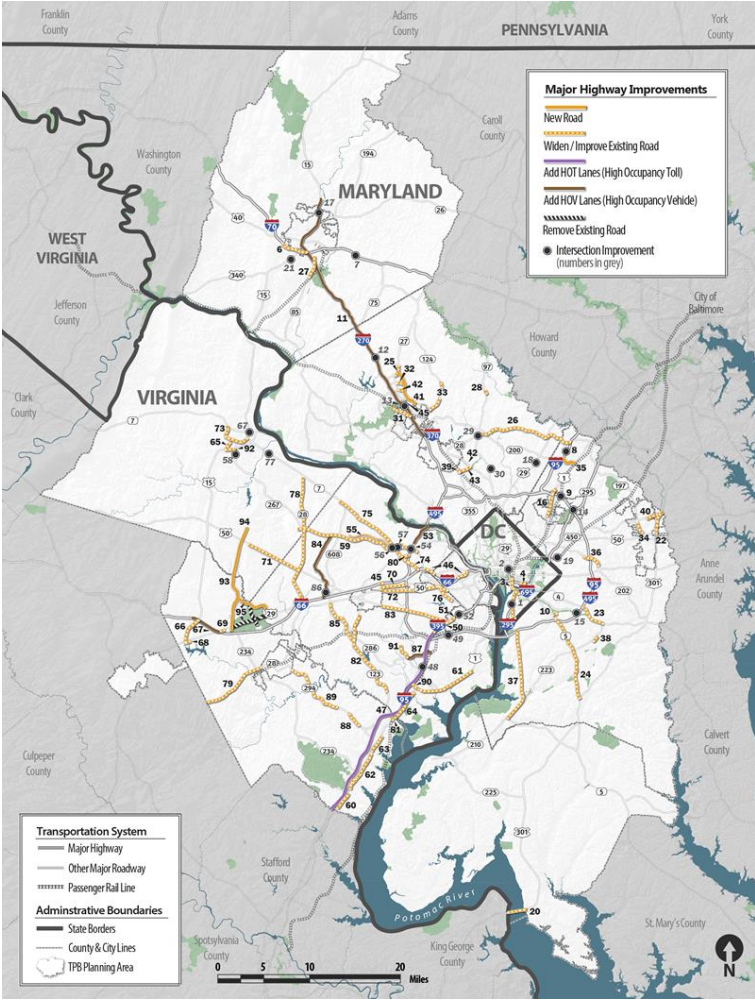
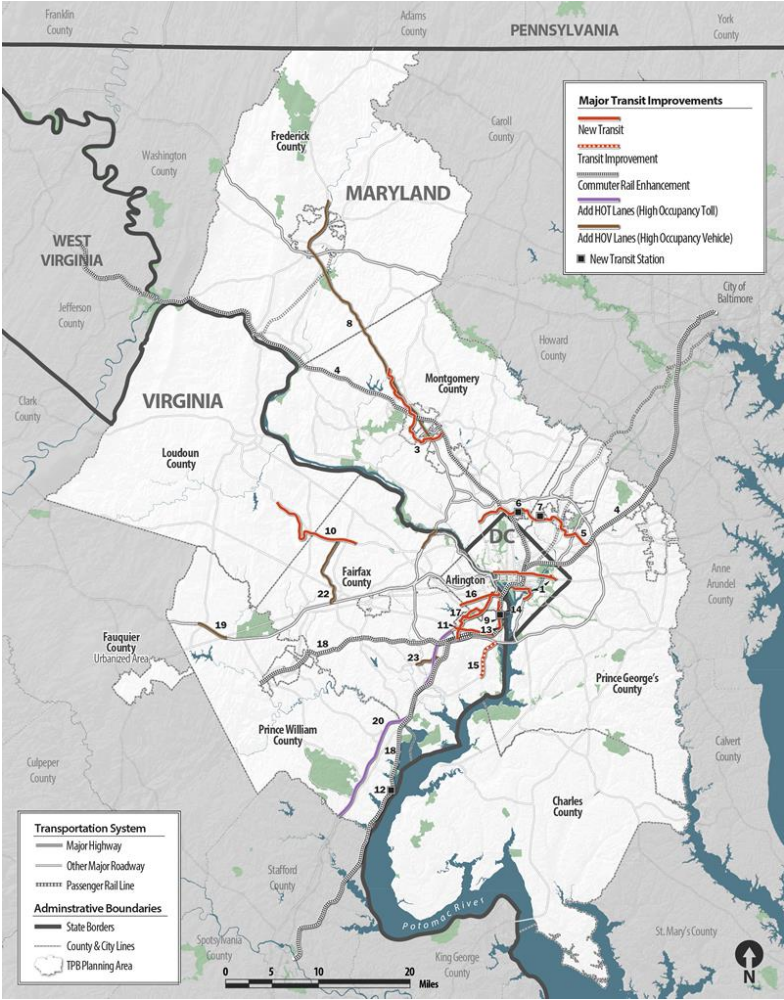

# Two Phase Approach to LRP Environmental Justice Analysis

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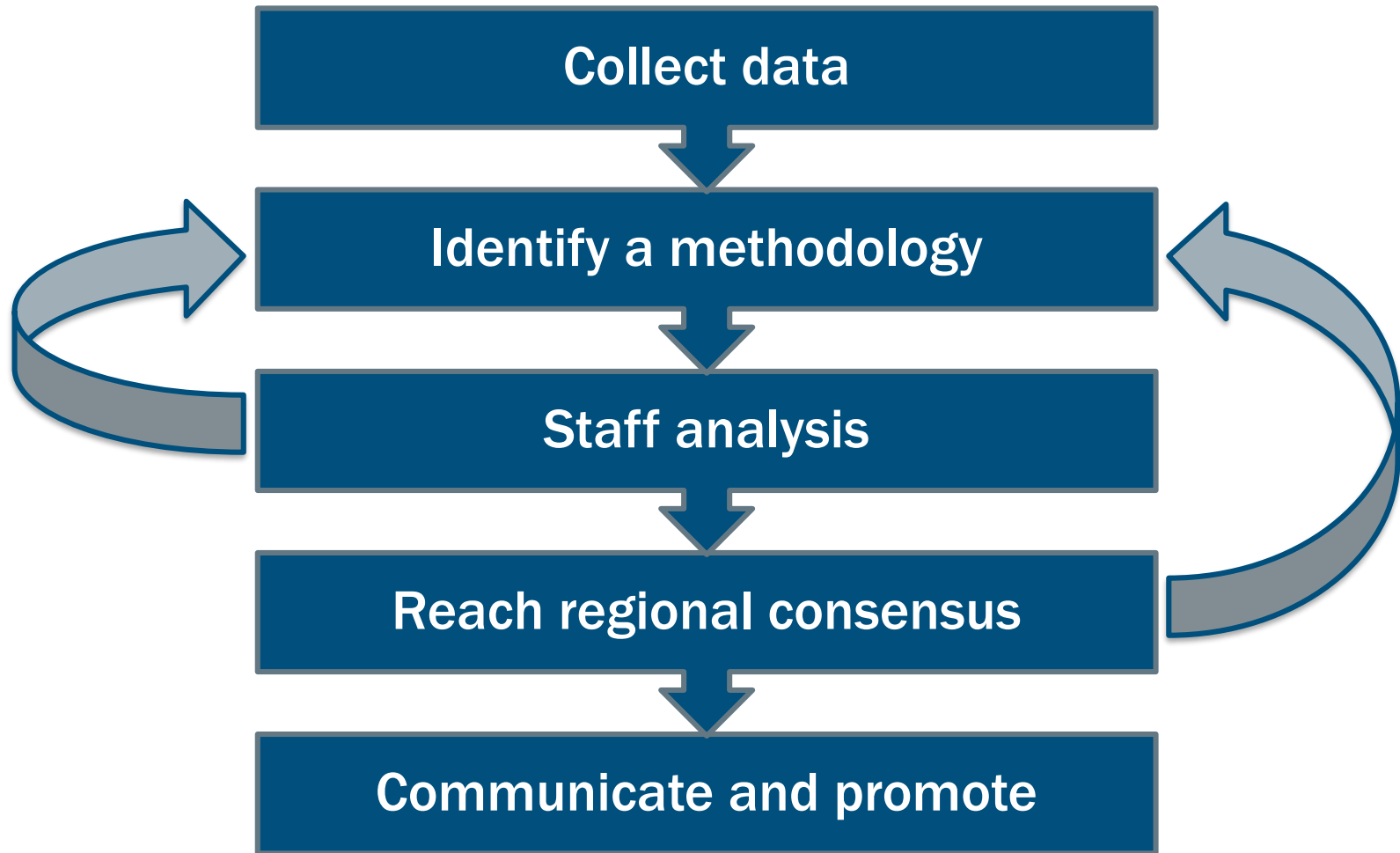
**Examine the Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan for any disproportionately high and adverse impacts on low-income and minority populations.**

**Phase 1:** Identification of concentrations of low-income and/or minority populations (“Equity Emphasis Areas”).

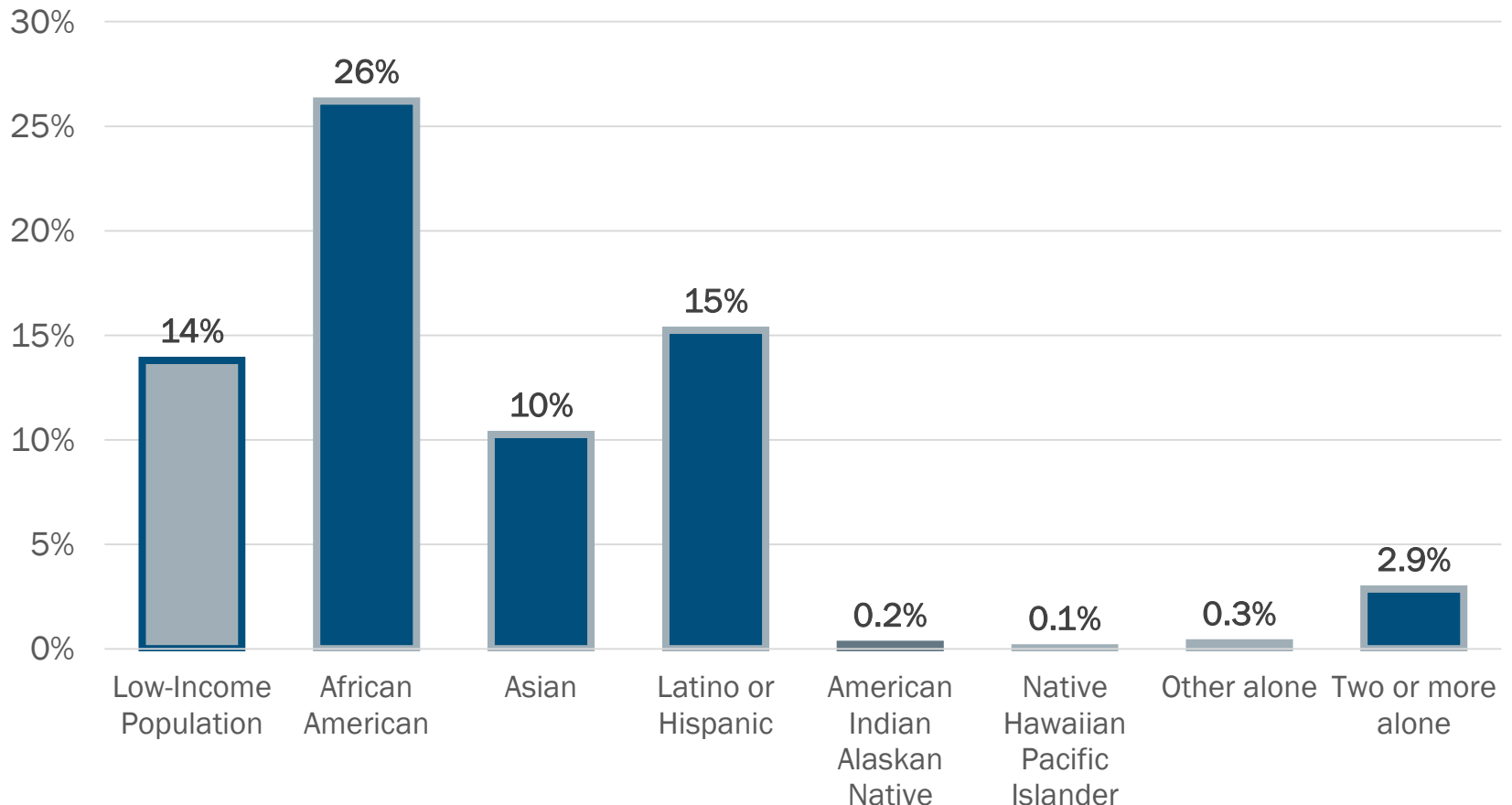
**Phase 2:** Using the travel demand model, analyze the 2016 CLRP amendment using multiple accessibility and mobility measures.

# What are Equity Emphasis Areas?

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**Criteria 1:** Tract with concentration of **low-income**\* greater than the **150%** the region average.

**Criteria 2:** Tract with at least **150%** concentration each of two or more **minority** groups.

**OR**

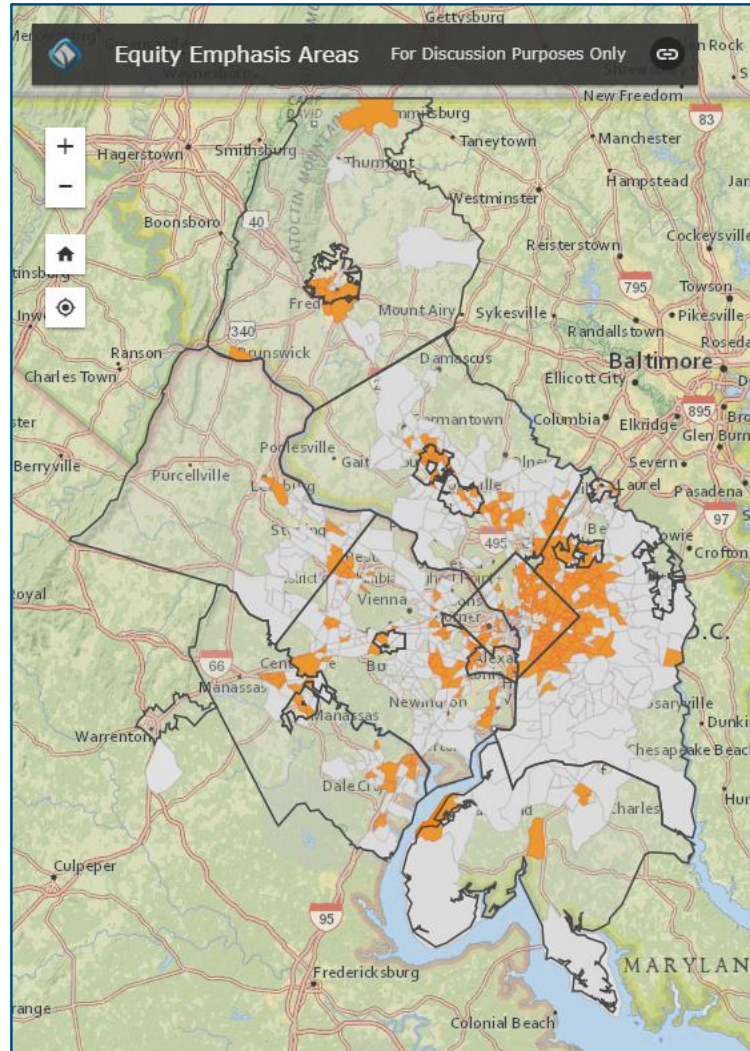
**Very high concentration of one **minority** group AND **low-income** above the regional average.**

\*Low-income is defined as a household income less than 1.5 times the Federal poverty level, depending on size.

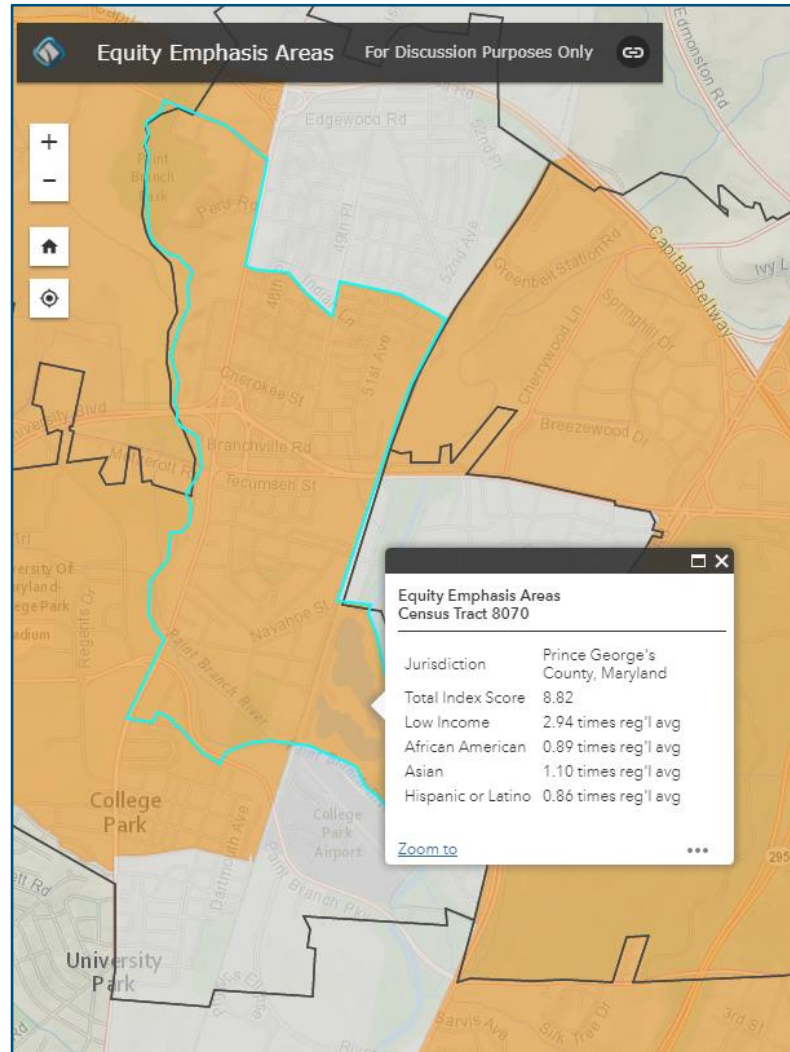

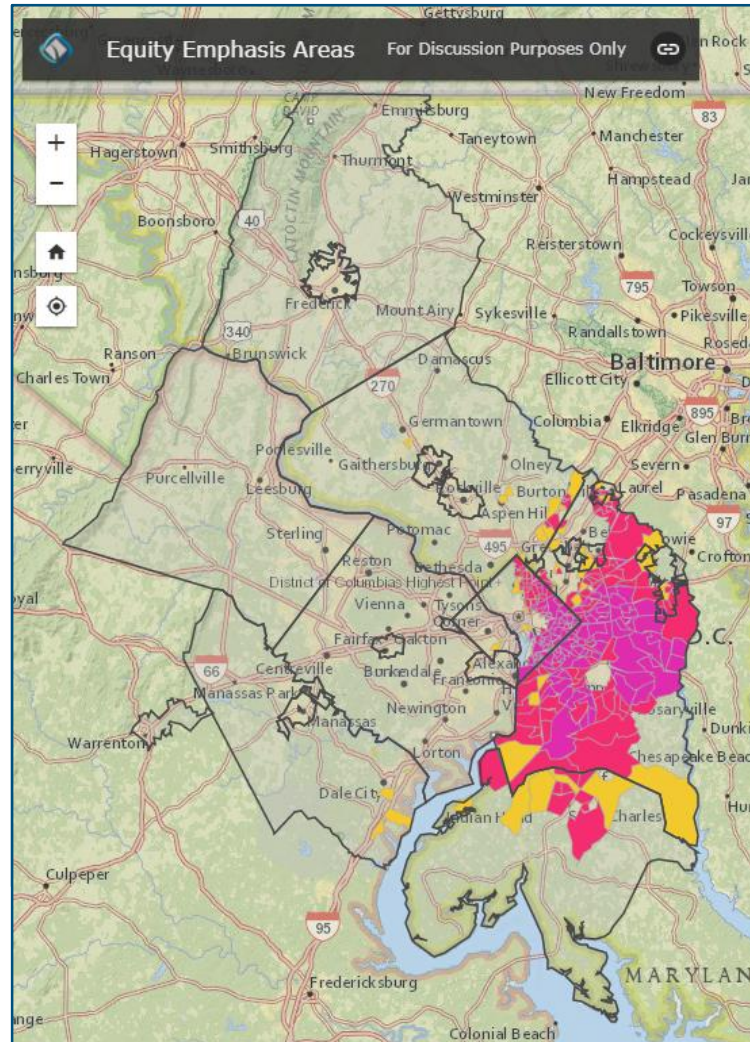

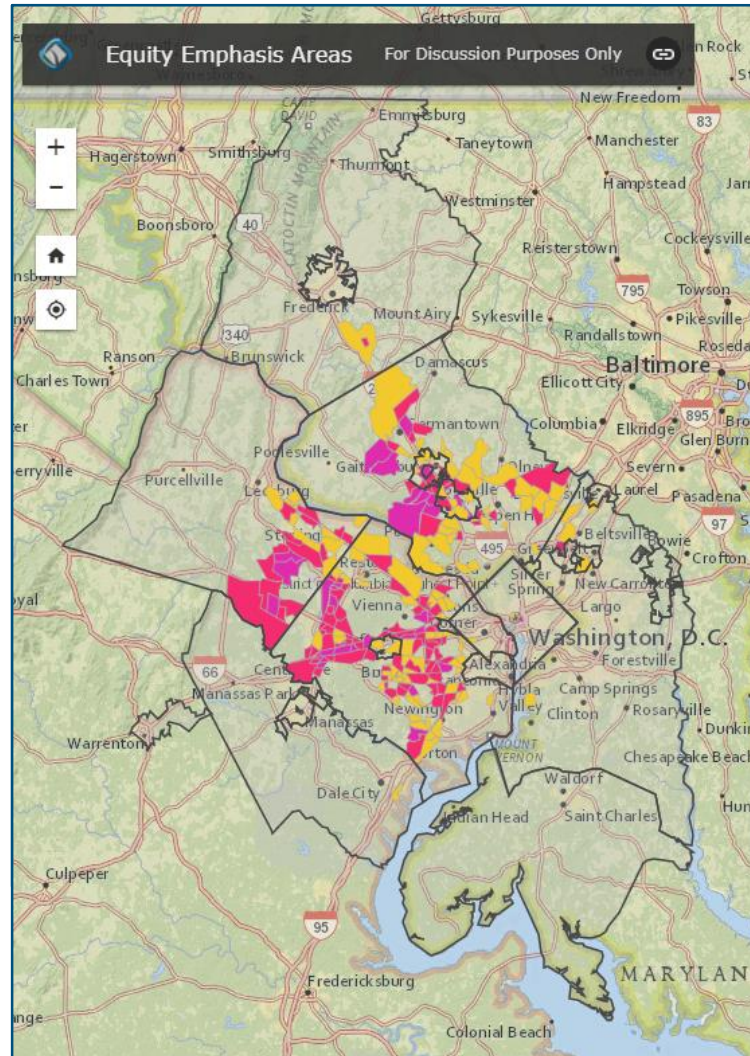

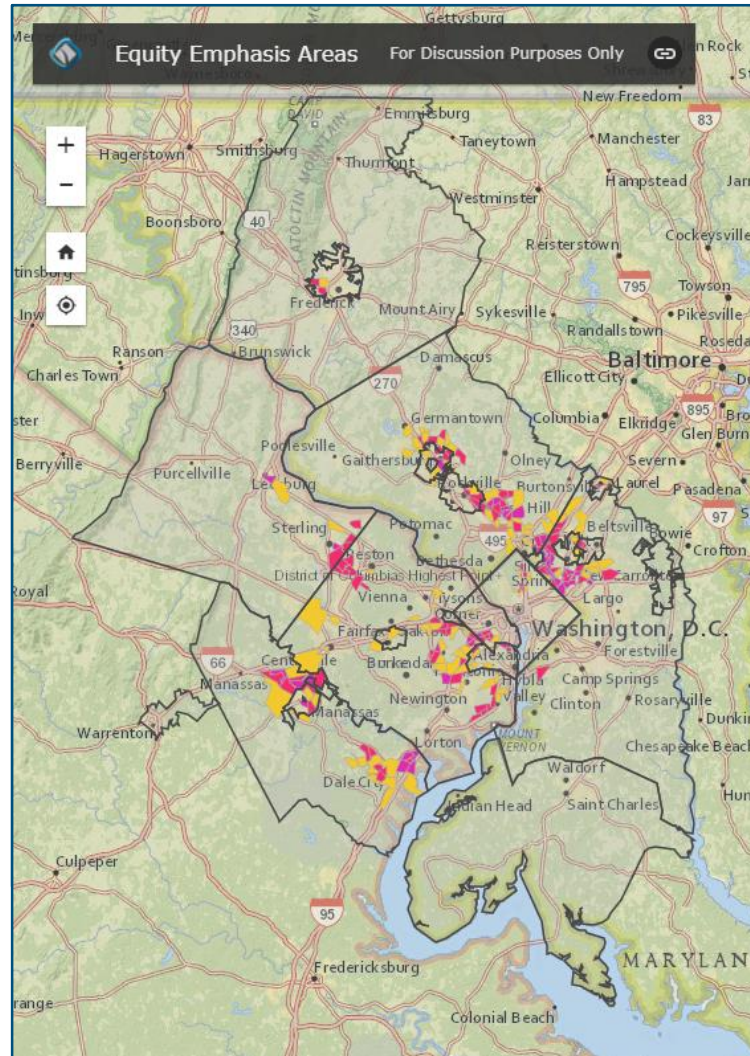

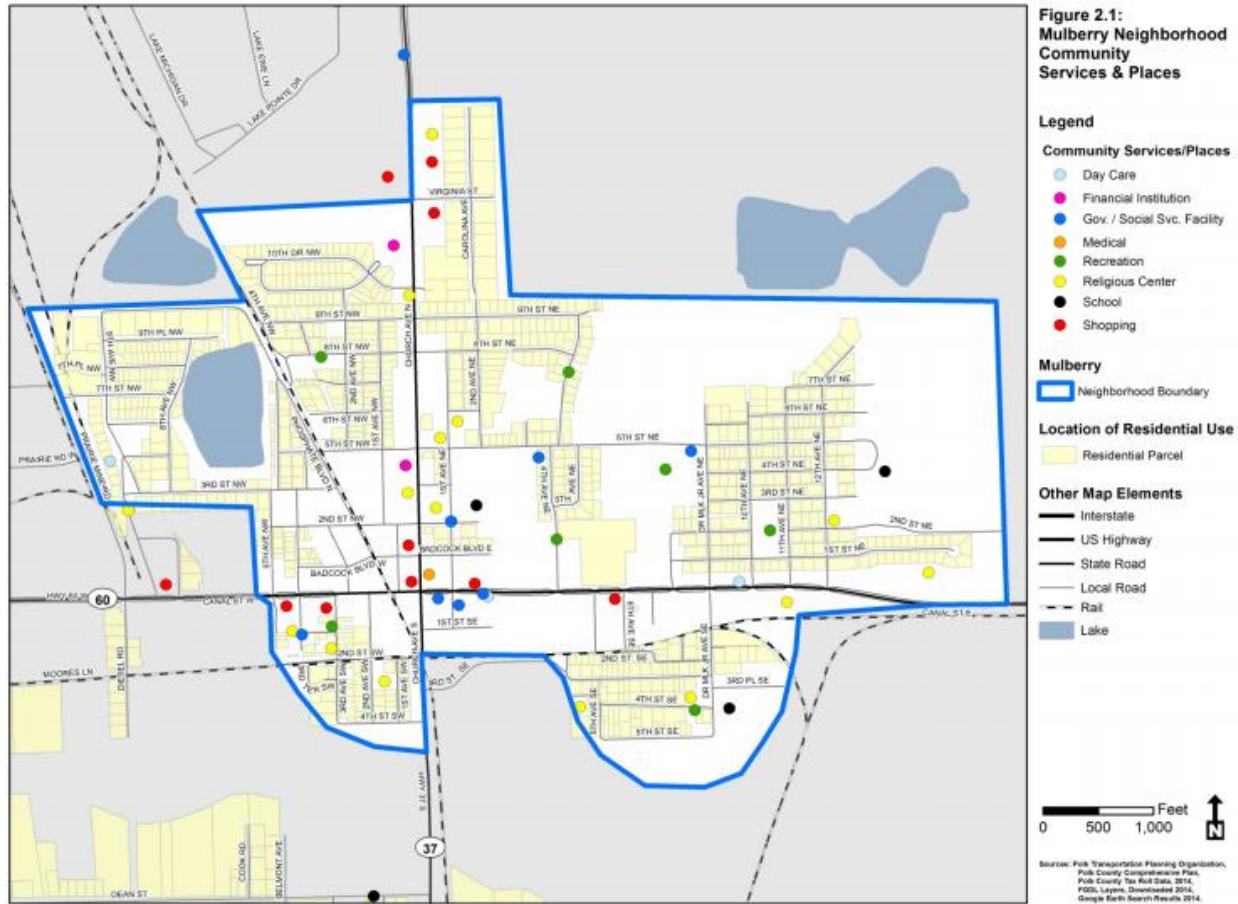

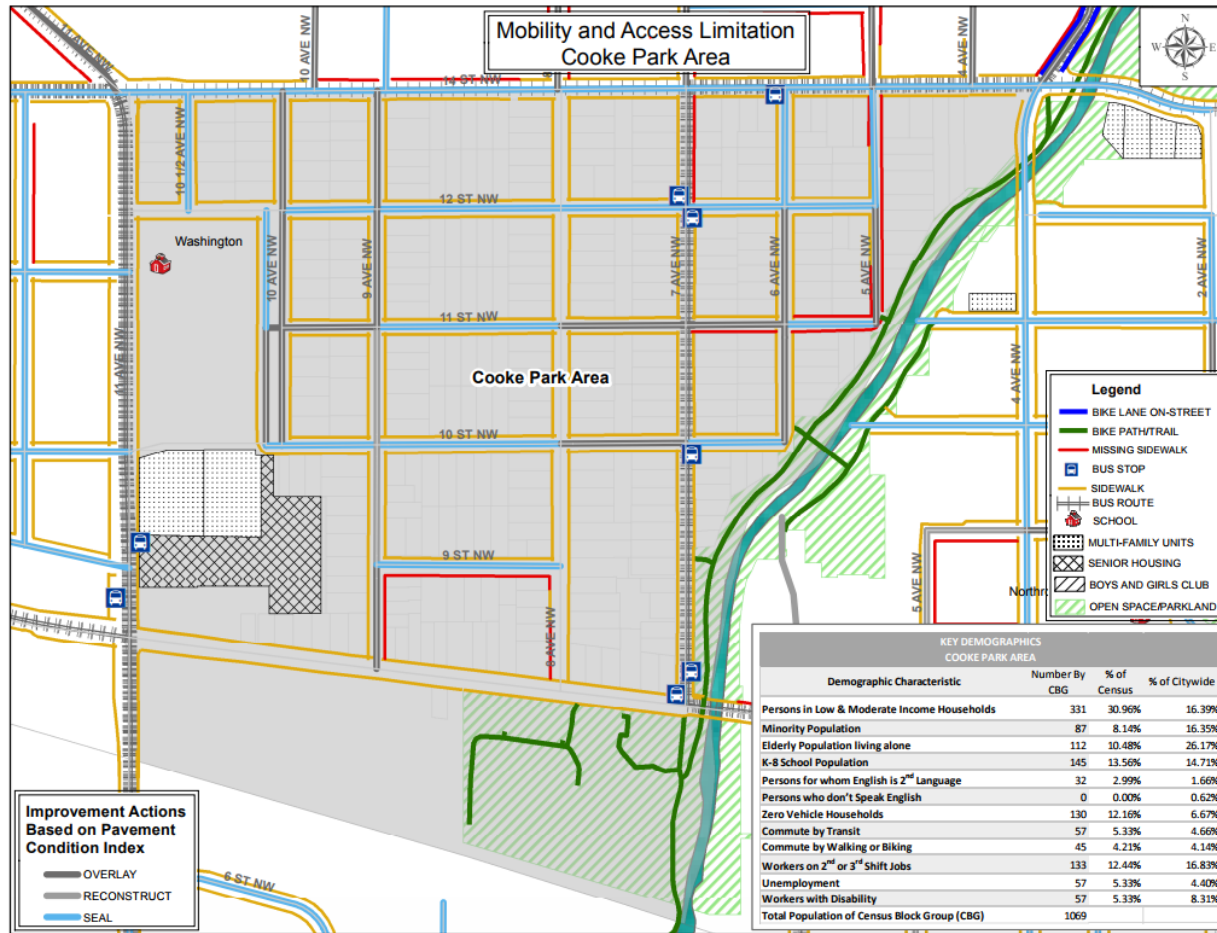

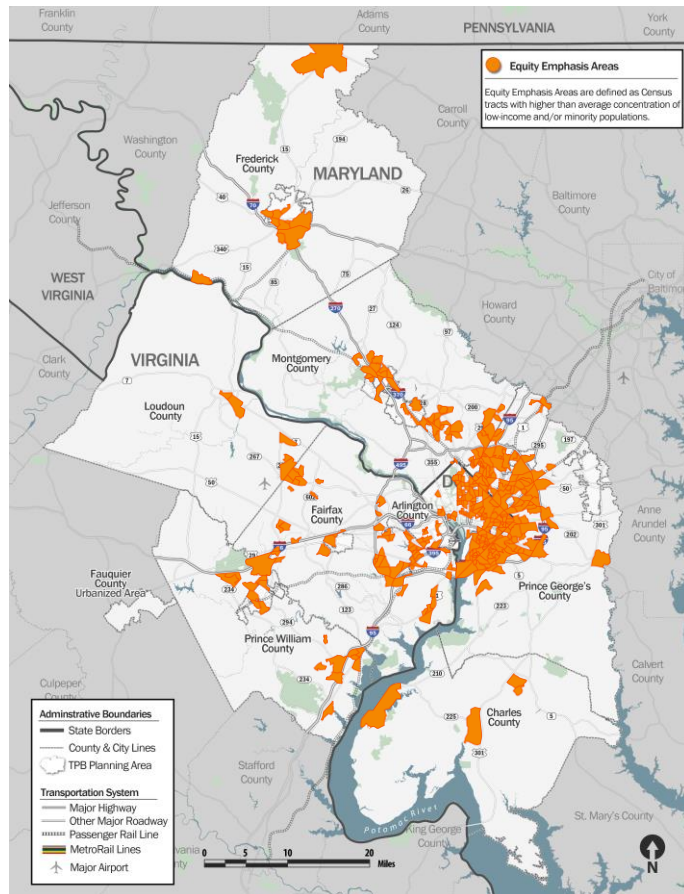
