In response to the TPB comments at the January 19 meeting, staff briefed the Committee on the bicycle and pedestrian plans in the region and on the context for the priority unfunded regional bicycle and pedestrian projects recommended for consideration in the FY 2006-2011TIP by the Bicycle and Pedestrian Subcommittee.

The Committee was briefed on the status of staff work to develop proposals to restructure and streamline the Commuter Connections Work Program (CCWP) for FY 2006 (July 1,2005 through June 30, 2006).

> The Committee was briefed by the implementing agencies on their significant project submissions for the 2005 CLRP and FY 2006-2011 TIP. The Committee recommended that these submissions be released for public comment and agency review at the TPB Citizens Advisory Committee meeting on February 10.

> The Committee was briefed on the draft scope of work for the air quality conformity assessment of the 2005 CLRP and FY 2006-2011 TIP. Staff also reviewed recent EPA information regarding the conformity implications of the new air quality standards for fine particles (PM2.5).
