Business Directory by Material

Important Reminders

- Always call ahead to confirm hours of operation and assure acceptance of materials you wish to recycle.
- Do not bring hazardous or toxic materials, unless you know for certain that the facility accepts them.
- Most recycling facilities reserve the right to reject any load that is too contaminated or otherwise unacceptable. Some will charge penalty fees for too much contamination.
- The purer and cleaner your load, the more valuable it is.
- Arrive in time to unload, pay, and leave before the facility closes.
- Some companies require that you set up an account or sign a contract with them before you can bring your materials.
- Many recycling facilities have safety rules, and some require you to wear a hard hat and steel toed safety shoes on premises.

Business Listings Terminology

- Buyback** business will pay for materials.
- Donation** business will accept materials free of charge. You donate your materials to the facility.
- Fee** business will charge for collection service or for accepting dropped-off materials.
- Drop-off** business will accept materials delivered to their facilities (restrictions may apply).
- Pickup** business may provide collection service.

Business Directory by Materials



Metals

Included scrap appliances.

Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners must be discharged of all Freon and other hazardous refrigerants. This should be done by a certified professional and properly documented. The appliance should be properly labeled to indicate that it has been discharged.

Drums and buckets should be empty and clean. Some dealers require that the tops of drums be removed.

Materials: Antiques and architectural salvage, appliances, plumbing hardware and fixtures (must be complete, very clean and in good condition), cabinetry (must be complete units, structurally intact), carpet, drywall, electrical components (must be working with all parts), flooring (size restrictions apply, see website), window/plate glass panes, paint, ceramic tiles (no less than 25 sq. ft.), roofing (new only), wood products (lumber must be 3-8 ft. in length and cannot have nails), doors and windows, building supplies and salvage, other reusable building supplies.

Drop-off: Donation.

Pickup: Donation, 15' box truck, Montgomery County only.
