School Facilities of MCPS

- MCPS has 194 Schools and almost
 140,000 students, largest district in MD
- Overall almost 20 million sf of facilities
- FY 2007 2012 CIP \$1.17 billion
- FY 2007 Operating Budget \$1.8 billion
- Increase in enrollment and class size
 reduction = 720 portable classrooms

- Mandatory since 2004











\$33 million = **\$1.65/sf/year**




