- Specialty Adhesive Remover
- Contact Adhesives: General Purpose and Special Purpose
- Electrical Cleaner
- Electronic Cleaner
- Fabric refresher: aerosol and non-aerosol
- Footware or Leather Care: aerosol and solid and all other forms
- Graffiti Remover: aerosol and non-aerosol
- Hair Styling: aerosol & pump spray and all other forms
- Toilet/Urinal Care: aerosol and non-aerosol
- Wood Cleaner: aerosol and non-aerosol
