The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (MWAA) is constructing a 23-mile extension of the existing Metrorail system, which will be operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority from East Falls Church to Washington Dulles International Airport west to Ashburn. The extension will serve Tysons Corner, Virginia's largest employment center, and the Reston Herndon area, the state's second largest employment concentration. **Transforming Tysons: Comprehensive Plan and Implementation**

In June 2010, Fairfax County adopted a new Comprehensive Plan for Tysons that re-envisioned the area as a series of walkable urban neighborhoods centered on four new Metro stations. In addition to encouraging transit-oriented densities and mixed use development, the plan sets bold goals for workforce housing, environmental stewardship, and multi-modal transportation networks. Following the plan’s adoption, Fairfax County turned its efforts to implementation, including processing over a dozen rezoning applications and creating detailed parks and public facility plans, urban design guidelines, and street design standards.
