Drivers of GHG Change Project

- MWCOG is a partner on a national grant team under the US Department of Energy CLEAP (Cities Leading through Energy Analysis and Planning) Program. Two main tasks include:
 - Develop new inventory (2015) and condition last inventory (2012).
 - Support development of a GHG drivers of change model and toolkit for local community-scale inventories. Test model with 2 regional inventory years.






Leading Drivers of Change, 2012-2015


Mid-Level Summary of Drivers, 2012-2015


Detailed Drivers Chart, 2012-2015
