- Established by state law
- 7 Members Each (21 total)
 - 2 Senate
 - 3 House
 - 1 Administration (Cabinet-level)
 - 1 Citizen

- Mean depth = 21 ft. (excluding channel = 6 ft.)
- 180,000 miles of rivers, creeks and streams
- 17.8 million people







HB 1325 and 1394 Local ability to assess stormwater fee




URBAN NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT

Taking the Phosphorus out of maintenance fertilizers while reducing nitrogen amounts



FARM BILL RCPP

\$8M over 5 years (4 Federal, 4 state) targeting three watersheds in Lancaster and York Counties and involving four state agencies, two conservation districts, six non-profits, & 1 industry organization



ENDOCRINE DISRUPTORS & HERBICIDES

HB 1737 would promote the collection and proper disposal of pharmaceuticals.

PA: Funding

- Estimated need in Bay Watershed (PA)
 \$378 M/y
- Current funding\$128 M/y statewide
