TPB and Agency staff recently completed the bulk import phase of the bicycle/pedestrian project database, for which the submission deadline was September 9. Further additions/edits will go through the Infotrak on-line portal.

InfoTrak is replacing the iTIP database as the means of collecting data for the Visualize 2045 long-range transportation plan, the Transportation Improvement Program, air quality conformity analysis, the Congestion Management Process, and the Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan.
