 Greenway, I-495 and I-95 Express Lanes








NORTHERN REGION OPERATIONS

 - 1000-1100 per month
 - 70% cleared < 45 min
- Number of Assists Handled by SSP
 - 2600-2800 per month

SAFETY SERVICE PATROL

Safety Service Patrol – 24/7; 14 routes; 70 people

- Primary Goal
 - Detect incidents & disruptions in traffic
 - Minimize incident duration w/ safe quick clearance
 - Establish temporary traffic control
 - Operate as an integrated extension of the TOC Floor
 - Carry the right tools (i.e. stockpiling absorbent)
- Secondary Goal
 - Assist motorists

- STARS Radios
 - Same frequency as Virginia State Police
- Push disabled vehicles










