ConnectGreaterWashington: Policy Alternatives to the 2040 Regional Transit System Plan was last presented with the Planning Directors in September 2014. At that time, we were beginning to model three scenarios that included a variety of policies to understand if the region might better utilize the 2040 base transit network. These policies included shifts in land use, changes to the cost of driving, changes to transit fares, increases in teleworking, increases to walk and bike trips, and/or other trends. The project also engaged transportation and land use professionals through a MetroQuest survey. Today, we will be presenting findings and conclusions from the analysis.
