

Our goals at the outset

- Fresh, new look
- One or two words, not the full name of the plan (or meaningless acronyms!)
- Communicate a key message, if possible
- Easy to use across web, print, and social media
- Aligned with TPB brand
- And... KEEP IT SIMPLE!



How we got to where we are

- Surveyed peer MPOs and local agencies
- Contracted with outside designer
- Three rounds of designs so far
- Gathered internal feedback (including from CAC)
- Working to narrow down options for <u>name</u>, <u>colors</u>, <u>fonts</u>, <u>text orientation</u>, <u>graphic element</u>



Round 1: Name, Colors, Graphics







- We explored different names, colors, and graphic elements
- "Visualize" was seen as the most compelling and interesting name
- There was a general aversion to the map and dome icons, as well as the orange and blue color combination
- We asked the designer to further develop Visualize, with a focus on developing a graphic element that communicated geographic specificity or something related to transportation



Round 2: Name, Colors, Graphics









- The designer narrowed in on a few color combinations and played with different graphic concepts: "road," "skyline," "nodes + connections"
- There was general consensus that "skyline" would be a difficult sell to outer jurisdictions and that "nodes + connections" seemed a little busy
- We asked the designer to give us a few more treatments of "roads" and "nodes + connections"
