



- Increase capacity and efficiency
- Remove bottlenecks

Virginia Avenue Tunnel

- Investment: \$160 million

 - Jobs: 2,000 in DC/VA
 - Community development
 - Pollution reduction: air, noise, river, congestion


- Increase intermodal capacity
