- Locomotive




Reduce Emissions from Land-Based Non-Road Vehicles



## Benefits Similar to HDD Rule




## Phased-In Emission Controls

Full implementation, complete fleet turnover could reduce estimated 70 tpd NOx and 35 tpd VOC.

Full benefits from this rule will not accrue until the entire fleet is replaced with new, clean equipment.
