Freight Around the Region Project

TPB freight staff continue to work with jurisdictions, railroads, and businesses to develop content for the Freight Around the Region Project. The Project aims to describe the connection between goods movement and the economy from the local level to the regional level. TPB staff will provide an update to the TPB Technical Committee on October 4th.

Rail Line Ownership/Rail Station Map

Virginia Railway Express is developing a System Plan that includes future operation alternatives. The System Plan under development will be finalized in December to coincide with the VRE Operations Board meeting.
