Ms. Rutherford will present PGLitterTRAK, an app that will be used by County residents and community groups that are interested in reporting their efforts to reduce litter in their communities. PGCLitterTRAK will serve as a tracking tool to aid residents in keeping track of removed litter, the amount of bagged trash and items removed from various locations in the County. Data collected by PGCLitterTRAK will be used for annual reporting documents to the Maryland Department of the Environment.
