



FRAMEWORK LAYERS

SMART DEVICES:

Sensors, meters, video cameras, smartphones, mobile devices

CONNECTED SOLUTIONS:

Cloud storage, predictive analytics, artificial intelligence

STANDARDIZED ENVIRONMENT:

Processes, standards, policies, privacy, rules & regulations
