At its meeting on January 5, 2007, the TPB Steering Committee approved the following resolution:

• TPB SR16-2007 on amendments to the FY 2006-2011 and FY 2007-2012 Transportation Improvement Programs (TIP) that are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement to add an enhancement project in the City of Fairfax, a traffic signal and ITS project, two safety projects, and six maintenance projects, as requested by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT).

The TPB Bylaws provide that the Steering Committee "shall have the full authority to approve non-regionally significant items, and in such cases it shall advise the TPB of its action."

RESOLUTION ON AMENDMENTS TO THE FY 2006- 2011 and FY 2007-2012 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM S(TIP) THAT ARE EXEMPT FROM THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY REQUIREMENT TO ADD AN ENHANCEMENT PROJECT IN THE CITY OF FAIRFAX, A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND ITS PROJECT, TWO SAFETY PROJECTS, AND SIX MAINTENANCE PROJECTS, AS REQUESTED BY THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (VDOT)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act - A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2005 the TPB adopted the 2005 CLRP and the FY 2006-2011 TIP; and

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2006 the TPB adopted the 2006 CLRP and the FY 2007-2012 TIP; and

WHEREAS, in the attached letter of December 15, 2006, VDOT has requested amendments to the FY 2006-2011 and FY 2007-2012 TIPs to include an enhancement project in the City of Fairfax, a traffic signals and ITS district wide project, two safety district wide projects, and six maintenance district wide projects, as described in the attached materials; and

WHEREAS, these projects are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement, as defined in Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations "40 CFR Parts 51 and 93 Transportation Conformity Rule Amendments: Flexibility and Streamlining; Final Rule," issued in the May 6, 2005, *Federal Register*,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Steering Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board amends the FY 2006-2011 and FY 2007-2012 TIPs to include an enhancement project in the City of Fairfax, a traffic signals and ITS district wide project, two safety district wide projects, and six maintenance district wide projects, as described in the attached materials.

VDOT's Northern Virginia District Office requests amending the FY 2007-2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to add one enhancement project, one ITS project, two safety projects, and six maintenance projects. The proposed amendments are categorically exempt from air quality conformity analysis. VDOT requests this amendment be approved by the TPB's Steering Committee at its meeting on January 5, 2007.

VDOT Enhancement Project:

• <u>Historic Blenheim Estate Facility Rehabilitation – City of Fairfax</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$59K in FY07 for preliminary engineering and \$66K in FY07 for construction using Federal STP funds.

VDOT ITS Project:

• <u>Traffic Signals and ITS System – Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.

- <u>Roadside Safety Improvements Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
- <u>Roadside Safety Assessment Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$332K in FY07 for preliminary engineering in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.

VDOT Maintenance Projects:

- <u>Install Guardrail Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
- <u>Shoulder Improvements Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
- <u>Install Traffic Markings Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$2,452K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
- <u>Install Traffic Signs Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
- <u>Install Rumble Strips Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
- <u>Install Roadway Lighting Districtwide</u>. This is a new TIP project and will add \$1,343K in FY07 for construction in FY07 using Federal STP/HES funds.
