

TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights

June 4, 2010

The Technical Committee met on June 4 at COG. Six items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on June 16.

- TPB agenda Item 8

The Committee was briefed on the 2010 solicitation and competitive selection process for the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA's) Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) and New Freedom program funding for the Washington Urbanized Area. At the June 16 meeting, the TPB will be asked to approve the selected projects for funding.

- TPB agenda Item 9

The Committee was briefed on a proposed regional bike sharing project that is under development for a pre-application under the new US DOT TIGER II program. The pre-application is due on July 16, with a final application due on August 23, 2010.

- TPB agenda Item 10

The Committee was briefed on a proposed draft TPB response to the request by Martz National Coach for federal assistance for commuter bus service between Fredericksburg and Washington DC.

- TPB agenda Item 11

Staff briefed the Committee on recommendations from the Strategic Plan for the Management, Operations, and Intelligent Transportation Systems (MOITS) Program. The TPB received a short preliminary briefing on this plan at the May 19 meeting, and asked that the plan be brought back as an action item for the June 16 meeting.

- TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was briefed on a summary of the comments and discussions by the participants at seven tables at the Conversation on Setting Regional Transportation Priorities that was held on May 26. At its July meeting, the Committee will discuss its recommendations for the TPB regarding potential next steps.

- TPB agenda Item 13

Staff briefed the Committee on the recently completed benefit-cost analysis for MATOC and the status of MATOC funding support.

Five items were presented for information and discussion:

- Staff updated the Committee on activities and progress on implementing the TPB Regional Priority Bus Project under a \$58 million TIGER grant being administered by FTA.
- WMATA staff briefed the Committee on the development of the WMATA Regional Transit System Plan for 2040.
- Staff briefed the Committee on the draft *National Capital Region Freight Plan 2010* prepared by the Freight Subcommittee.
- Staff updated the Committee on the status of the financial analysis for the 2010 CLRP.
- A briefing on the final draft 2010 Congestion Management Process (CMP) Technical Report was deferred to the July 9 meeting.
