This letter transmits the following data in response to the letter request of October 26, 2004, from Ms. Amy L. Horner of Sidley Austin Brown & Wood. LLP:

1. Highway and transit networks, input, control, support and TP+ script files and software to run the demographic sub-models and accomplish trip generation, trip distribution, mode choice and traffic assignment using the COG/TPB Travel Forecasting Model Version 2.1/TP+, (Draft # 50) for three time periods. These data are for the simulation years 2005, 2015MP, 2015NA, 2025MP, 2025NA, 2030MP and 2030NA from the 2005 Constrained Long Range Plan (CLRP)/FY 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Air Quality Conformity regional modeling process currently under public review until October 31, 2004. This process covers the 2191-Transportation Analysis Zone (TAZ)/487 Transportation Analysis District (TAD) Expanded Cordon Region and uses forecasts of population, households and employment from Round 6.4A of the COG Cooperative Forecasting process. The data are contained on a CD-R marked "SMARTMOBAQ 2004". The Air Quality Conformity data are contained in a directory titled "2005Conformity_CGV21D_50".

Please note that generic file names are used in these model runs, so it is recommended that the data for each simulation year be kept in separate directories.


