## Survey of Local Air Quality Programs

The Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) is developing a new air quality plan to meet the federal standards for ozone. MWAQC has asked COG staff to collect data on programs being implemented by local jurisdictions that provide air quality benefits for possible inclusion in the State Implementation Plan (SIP) for meeting EPA's 8-hour ozone standard.

Programs that have been identified as priorities for potential inclusion in the SIP include:

- Renewable Energy/Wind Energy Purchase Commitments
- School Bus Retrofits
- Other Diesel Vehicle Retrofits
- Low-Emission Vehicle Purchases
- Use of Low VOC Paints
- LED Traffic Signal Retrofits
- Energy Efficiency Programs/Energy Performance Contracting

Other programs that are being considered include:

- Urban Heat Island Mitigation and Tree Canopy Programs
- Green Building Initiatives
- Enhanced Enforcement (Idling, Solvent Cleaning)

Attached please find survey forms for use in reporting data on programs in your jurisdiction. COG staff will use the information provided to estimate air emission benefits of the programs.

Provision of data does not constitute a commitment to implement any measures for the SIP. Those decisions and written commitments will be under the purview of each participating jurisdiction. Please see the attached process and schedule for developing local voluntary program commitments for the SIP.
