- MWAQC Budget Committee had 2 calls to discuss work program (Mar-May)
 - Agree to support core work program for FY 2015
 - Proposed budget is the same as FY 2014
- TPB adopted Transportation Unified Plan and Work Program in March
 - Used 2014 MWAQC contribution amount
 - Need to revise once DOT allocation announced
- Special Project funded by MDE

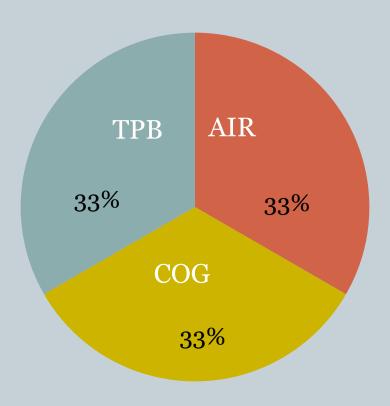


- Plan for ozone control measures to meet 2008 federal ozone standard (75 ppb)

- Review transportation conformity analyses for ozone, fine particles, carbon monoxide
 - MOVES2014 mobile inventories
