

### **Background – Population & Households**

- □ PWC Population & Household data are reconciled at the Decennial Census
  - 2010 Census difference with PWC Data was approximately 1.5%
- □ PWC has established methodology to determine Population & Households for interim years (Prince William Report & Standard Data Set)
  - Building Occupancy Permits from permit tracking system
  - Permits are geo-coded by census tracts and precincts
  - Vacancy Rate and Household size applied from 2010 Census at the tract level
- □ PWC Population & Household data are the basis for forecasts






# **Household Type Distribution**

- ☐ Establish housing unit cap by type based on build-out analysis of Comprehensive Plan
- ☐ Single-family detached: logistic curve to show gradual moderation of growth
- ☐ Townhouses: Straight-line growth to cap
- Multi-family: Remainder of units based on the above


### **Housing Type Trends**

#### **Distribution of Households**

- □ For 2010 estimate of HH determine and apply Vacancy Rate from Census Tract that most closely aligns geographically with the PWC TAZ
- ☐ All subsequent years assume vacancy rate based on 2010 estimate
- Distribution
  - Establish build-out per TAZ (comprehensive plan adjusted to 2040)
  - Calculate # of new households for 5-year periods based on control totals
  - Distribute growth among TAZs proportionally based on capacity of TAZ

# **Population**

- □ Determine Household Size by Type (SFD, TH, MF)
  - Used blocks of homogenous household type from 2010 Census to determine average household size by type
  - Applied averages county-wide by type

### **Distribution of Population**

- □ Calculate population based on average household sizes by type from 2010 census
- ☐ Add group quarters population by PWC TAZ based on 2010 census and project growth in group quarters
- □ Reconcile variance from control total numbers by applying an adjustment factor for all TAZs for each 5 year period


### **Employment Data for PWC**

- ☐ At-Place Employment from VEC and InfoUSA
- ☐ Military Employment InfoUSA
- □ Self-Employment uses 5% additional employees
- Geocoded VEC and InfoUSA and reconciled
- □ Reconcile to control total for 2010
