As part of the maintenance plan for the 1997 fine particle standard, the region agreed to complete an analysis to explore if market forces result in cleaner products being distributed across the region even when the regulations for the cleaner products have only been adopted in part of the region. Ramboll Environ was hired to complete the analysis for residential heating oil and automotive coatings. Members will be briefed on the study, including survey results.
