RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A MARKET SURVEY OF ALTERNATIVE LAND APPLICATION SITES FOR BIOSOLIDS AND OTHER ORGANIC NUTRIENT SOURCES IN THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA (WMA)

WHEREAS, the WMA has a continuing need to manage the growing volume of biosolids from the wastewater plants that service its 4.5 million residents; and

WHEREAS, identifying alternative markets for future application of biosolids is an important step for continuing to manage this important byproduct of the region's wastewater plants; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments has provided assistance to wastewater officials in managing their biosolids; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Center for Agro-Ecology is a coalition of agricultural, environmental, forestry, business, educational, government and other leaders dedicated to enhancing Maryland's farms, forests and other "working lands" through research, education and policy programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

The Executive Director, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a cooperative agreement to work with the Maryland Center for Agro-Ecology to perform an organic nutrients survey and market evaluation for the Washington Metropolitan Area in conjunction with all COG member jurisdictions. The funding amount for this agreement will be \$38,222 with funding provided by the Maryland Center for Agro-Ecology and a \$14,373 local match required. This agreement is for a period of one year beginning in spring 2007.
