



Background and Recent Changes

- December 2018 TPB
 Resolution R20-2019
 directed TPB staff to build
 upon the National Capital
 Trail to create a regional
 trail network that extends
 into all TPB member
 jurisdictions
- NCTN Presented to TPB in June 2020
- Received public comment
- Made changes in City of Manassas






Benefits

- Long-distance, continuous network of lowstress, mostly off-road bicycle and pedestrian facilities
 - 1400 miles of facilities (645 miles already exist)
- Accessible for all ages and abilities;
- Healthy, low-stress access to open space
- Clean, inexpensive, reliable transportation
- Serves most people, Activity Centers
 - 136 of 141 Activity Centers and 308 of 351 Equity Emphasis Areas are within
 ½ mile of the network

National Capital Trail (2018)




Transportation Planning Board

TPB Resolution R5-2021

- 1. Adopts the National Capital Trail Network.
- 2. Directs TPB staff to:
 - Give additional consideration to projects that will implement portions of the network for Transportation Alternatives and Transportation-Land Use Connections funding.
 - Report on progress towards implementation of the network on an annual basis.
 - Work with the TPB member jurisdictions to update the network, to reflect anticipated new agency bicycle and pedestrian plans, on an annual basis.
- 3. Asks TPB members to prioritize projects, programs, and policies that will implement portions of the National Capital Trail Network.



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
