TALKING POINTS ABOUT THE VISUALIZE 2045:

- Visualize 2045 is being developed by the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), the federally designated metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for metropolitan Washington. The TPB is housed at and staffed by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG).

The plan will include transportation projects in the region that we can reasonably expect to fund and also provide a rededication to equity, resiliency, and safer communities as we visualize our future. To get started the TPB conducted a regionwide survey and is scheduling focus groups to capture the story behind the data. Later in 2021, the TPB will be conducting outreach to communities throughout the region, respecting social distancing in consideration of public health directives.
