TPB CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE MONTHLY REPORT

The CAC met on Thursday, October 11 for a briefing on the Visualize 2045 performance analysis and to participate in a mapping activity.

VISUALIZE 2045: PERFORMANCE ANALYSIS

Sergio Ritacco, TPB transportation planner, briefed the committee on the performance analysis of the constrained element of Visualize 2045. He referenced Chapter 5 of the plan and talked about how changes in population and employment will impact the region, but also showed how planned projects can mitigate the impacts of that change on the region's transportation infrastructure.

MAPPING THE REGION'S TRANSPORTATION FUTURE

The committee participated in a mapping activity where they were asked to envision a transportation future that builds on Visualize 2045. As part of the activity, members were asked to identify locations for future population and employment growth and to build transportation infrastructure to support future growth.

Staff explained that this activity is an evolution of a game that has been used for scenario planning and the Community Leadership Institute in the past. Utilizing their knowledge of Visualize 2045, committee members made suggestions for updating the activity to better encapsulate the aspirational element of the plan. Specifically, they encouraged staff to think about how bicycle and pedestrian initiatives could be better reflected in the activity, possibly by changing the scale of the map. They also suggested factoring in housing and travel costs, and a way to represent different levels of density.

THE COMMITTEE ALSO DISCUSSED

- The committee learned that the WMATA board is considering disbanding the Riders Advisory Council. The CAC believes public participation is an important part of transportation planning and providing transportation services. The committee is disappointed about this possibility.
- Lyn Erickson, TPB Plan Development & Program Coordination Director, reviewed the agenda for the October TPB meeting.
