Recruitment and Completion Rates to Date

- As of September 20, 2018, there are 21,703 recruited households (50,247 persons) who completed the Part 1 survey
- As of September 20, 2018, there are 15,023 households (32,789 persons) who completed the travel diary (Part 2 survey)
- The conversion rate (% of recruited HHs who completed the survey) is 70%
- As of September 7, 2018, there were 112,517 trips and 40,971 vehicles recorded in the travel diary (Part 2 survey)

Hispanic/Latino Outreach Update

- Purpose: to address underrepresentation of Hispanic/Latino households in survey responses to date
- Target households in census block groups with high concentrations of Hispanic/Latino population who did not respond to the initial survey invitation
- Spanish surveys will be mailed to 7,500 households on Tuesday, September 25
- Spanish survey instrument and website finalized
- Dedicated Spanish toll-free call line established
- CASA de Maryland staff to assist walk-in participants



Looking Ahead: Survey Schedule

- Quarter 5 letter drops began on August 21, 2018
 - Letter drops for Arlington County add-on to begin October 2, 2018
 - Target number of additional samples for Arlington County is 578
- RTS data collection to conclude on December 31, 2018
- Post-survey processing (e.g., data cleaning, factoring, weighting) will begin January 2019 and continue into FY 2020
- Public release dataset anticipated in FY 2020
