

This session will review EPA's online energy management tool, Portfolio Manager, which allows you track the progress of energy efficiency efforts and compare the energy use of your buildings to peer buildings across the country. Attendees will learn how to measure and track energy use and carbon dioxide emission reductions to establish baseline energy use, prioritize investments, set goals, and track improvements over time.

This training will walk the attendees through four simple steps of benchmarking using Portfolio Manager. While the trainer shows these steps live using Portfolio Manager, attendees will be able to use their computers to benchmark one of their buildings in this secure environment:

- Open a Portfolio Manager account
- Add a property (facility/water or wastewater treatment plant etc.)
- Add a space (including a mix-use building)
- Add an energy meter
- Training will also include some features of Portfolio Manager including options for bulk data upload for larger portfolio of buildings.

At the end of this online training session, attendees will have benchmarked one building. *Attendees are encouraged to bring their building data.* For data requirements for different building types, please visit www.energystar.gov/benchmark.
