Although data for the 2008 ozone season is preliminary until EPA quality-assures the data in the spring, staff will give an overview of what the 2008 ozone and  $PM_{2.5}$  data show at this stage. - Appointment process and schedule is set (MWAQC appoints in January)

Item 5. Clean Data Determination: Update

Presenter: Joan Rohlfs, Chief, Air Quality Planning

### **Description:**

In September MWAQC voted to request EPA to issue a Clean Data Determination for fine particles (PM<sub>2.5</sub>) for the Washington metropolitan area. EPA's Clean Data Policy can be requested because the Washington region's monitor data has been in compliance with the 1997 federal health standards for fine particles since 2005.

In the October 22 edition of the Federal Register EPA proposed to issue a Clean Data determination for the Washington region. The comment period closes on November 21. Depending on comments received, EPA could issue the final Clean Data determination in December. The proposed action will require a redesignation request and maintenance plan or SIP, but there is no deadline for either to be submitted.
