Potholepalooza is On Again—Turn in those Nagging Potholes!

After success with the Potholepalooza program last year, DC Department of Transportation has launched another campaign. In last year's month-long campaign, the District patched more than 6,000 potholes that were either reported by the public or discovered by the city's crews. This year's campaign began over the weekend and will continue through April 5, 2010. The District's goal is to fix potholes within 48 hours after they are identified. People can report potholes by phone, online, twitter, or e-mail. Provide as much detail about the location, size, and depth of the pothole as possible.
