- SUBJECT: REVISED Schedule for Round 9.1 Cooperative Forecasts
- DATE: September 22, 2017

The Round 9.1 Cooperative Forecasts update is an opportunity for local governments to revise their forecasts of employment, population, and households. This Round has a particularly tight completion schedule and is intended for jurisdictions who see new economic or land use conditions that would impact their current forecasts, or to reflect on impacts due to new transportation facilities.

After further conversations with COG's Transportation staff, the original January 26<sup>th</sup> deadline does not allow enough time for COG staff to check and verify the TAZ level data for the large number of jurisdictions currently intending to update their forecasts. In order for the Transportation staff to remain on schedule, the Planning Directors must approve the new "benchmark" totals by Friday. December 15, 2017 and the COG staff must receive the TAZ forecast data by Friday, January 12, 2018. We have discussed this schedule with the Cooperative Forecasting Subcommittee and understand that they have discussed with you any need to update Forecasts for your jurisdiction.
